- Maintain GIS content to ensure datasets and spatial tools are current, accurate and relevant
- Use geoprocessing tools to create, edit and enrich spatial and non-spatial datasets
- Compile, organize, and manage, data generated from large field data collection efforts
- Configure and setup web maps and survey123 forms for field data collection
- Configure and maintain operational dashboard apps to monitor field data collection
- Coordinate GIS activities with project scientists, clients, regional offices, and other analysts
- Provide data analysis, presentation, and reporting
- Support cartography standards for organizational mapping deliverables

Although not required, a degree or coursework in environmental or natural science or experience in environmental consulting is beneficial. Other beneficial qualifications include programming (Python, Java, VB, .NET, SQL), ArcGIS Server, SQL Server, Model Builder, AutoCAD, as well as a basic understanding of IT concepts.
